Hall Planning & Engineering, Inc. participated as a subconsultant with EDAW to develop a transportation plan for the new Ave Maria Town and Campus, located in Collier County, Florida. HPE provided the design team with expertise on street design for walkability, designing thoroughfares to maximize pedestrian circulation while still permitting vehicle circulation, connectivity, and on-street parking.

Transportation objectives included enhanced walkability and improved circulation. Experience with walkable street design in other areas enabled HPE to work effectively within the team to plan slower speed streets with adequate capacity to handle university and local circulation traffic. These well connected walkable streets were also designed to encourage the other non-automobile modes such as cycling and transit.

HPE also examined parking supply and demand and provided recommendations for on-street parking design.
