

FRUITVILLE ROAD PMI PLAN SARASOTA COUNTY, FL

Provided transportation planning and engineering services to support the Fruitville Road plan.

CLIENT'S NAME & ADDRESS:

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Hall Planning & Engineering, Inc. participated as a subconsultant with Moule-Polyzoides Architects & Urbanists, Inc., in the development of a development plan for the intersection of Fruitville Road and I-75 in Sarasota County, FL. The plan utilized the PMI form-based code specified by Sarasota County.

HPE participated in discovery meetings and a 5-day charrette to create a plan for the areas on the northeast and southeast quadrants of the intersection. HPE responsibilities included coordinating with the County and FDOT, thoroughfare assignment, and creation of new thoroughfares to fit site conditions. All transportation planning and engineering was conducted to promote walkability within the plan area, through managed traffic speeds, as well as connectivity between the plan area and the surrounding county. The interchange at I-75 and Fruitville Road was conceptually redesigned.

The final plan calls for the creation of a multi-way boulevard along Fruitville Road adjacent to the site, as well as a realignment of the ramps on the east side of I-75. HPE continues to work with Moule-Polyzoides and the county to complete and implement the plan.
